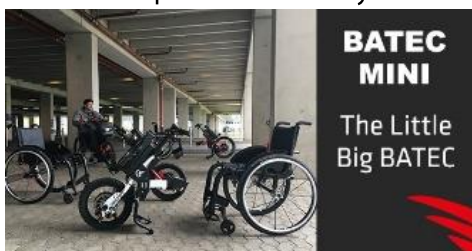
The Batec Mini container arrived, and we have all the colors and options available for delivery. Back orders have been cleared and we are good to go with new orders.
