- 70 years since the first wheelchair sport activity took place at Deer Lodge Rehabilitation Hospital in Winnipeg, MB
- 50 years since the Canadian Wheelchair Sports Association was incorporated
- 40 years since the Canadian Heritage Sport "Murderball" – or "Wheelchair Rugby" as it's now known – was invented in Winnipeg, MB

Stories and "fun facts" have been published and presentations of photos and memorabilia displayed at various events throughout the year.

Celebrations will culminate in a 70-50-40 Anniversary Celebration at the Westin Hotel in Ottawa from Friday, December 15th to Saturday, December 16th and conclude with a Gala event on the evening of December 16th, at which time they will unveil the names of those inducted into the CWSA Hall of Fame, a one-time event that recognizes those who have contributed so much to the wheelchair sport community in Canada and internationally since 1967.


