Hall of Fame

Congratulations to the Right Honourable Stephen Harper, Michelle Stilwell, and our own Chantal Benoit on the announcement that they will be inducted into the Canadian Disability Hall of Fame on October 13th, 2023.







The Right Honourable Stephen J. Harper dedicated significant efforts and resources towards improving the lives of people with disabilities. As Canada's 22nd Prime Minister, he empowered a team in cabinet and through Federal appointments that would help make life better for the community including the Registered Disability Savings Plan in 2008 and Paralympic funding initiatives.

Michelle Stilwell is a six-time gold medallist in wheelchair basketball and athletics, and a nine-time world champion. Stilwell has excelled in politics and business serving two terms as a Member of the Legislative Assembly in British Columbia, is an active member of multiple national and international boards, as well as overseeing operations of a public speaking company.

Chantal Benoit is widely recognized as one of the greatest female wheelchair basketball players in history. She achieved remarkable

success over more than two decades with the national team program and is a seven-time Paralympian with three gold medals and a bronze and a four-time world champion. Her contributions to the sport and advocacy for inclusivity led to her appointment to the Order of Canada and the International Wheelchair Basketball Federation Gold Medal Triad Award for her impact on the sport's growth. She is immensely proud of the honour of having a school bear her name (École élémentaire Chantal-Benoit) and is dedicated to providing as much support as she can to see that French immersion school be successful in achieving its educational, linguistic, inclusivity, sport, and active living goals.

Softwheels Technology

Softwheels are no longer fulfilling orders and parts are no longer available. We have not received any statement as to what the issues are and although the web site is still online the company is no longer active as a provider of suspension wheels for wheelchairs.

The company has parlayed their fundraising success into a new venture that they have been able to raise a significant amount of capital for in the automotive sector. The going concern web site is now <u>WWW.REE.AUTO</u> (logo is R3E). With the significant funding raised, they have developed a vehicle concept "Powered by REE" which is equipped with



"REEcorner™", taking care of vehicle components such as steering, braking, suspension, powertrain, and control into a

single compact module positioned between the chassis and the wheel. With this proprietary by-wire technology for drive, steer, and brake control that eliminate the need for mechanical connections, all four identical REEcorners™ enable REE to build the industry's flattest electric vehicle (EV) platforms with more room for passengers, cargo and batteries. "REE platforms are future proofed, autonomous capable, offer a low total cost of ownership (TCO), and drastically reduce the time to market for fleets looking to electrify".

At the end of Q2 2023 they apparently have liquidity of \$105 million US dollars. They have a few vehicles on the road now apparently and plan to ramp up to produce 300 more in 2024. They are targeting \$1 Billion US in sales by the end of 2026; but no Softwheel production!

Loopwheels <u>www.Loopwheels.com</u> are alive and well providing suspension product for our industry.

Softwheels. Technology REE. AUTO is looking for more investors as they will require an additional \$50 million to ramp up production and they have chosen to do that in a non-GAAP fashion. For those like this writer who are not familiar with all the acronyms that would mean non-generally accepted accounting principles.

It is unfortunate that this company has not seen the value in letting their former customers know why they are no longer selling their premium priced products for this industry and why they are not providing parts and pieces to those that require them; while their wheels are sitting collecting dust. One thing is for sure, this writer will not be investing in a company that treats its former customers in this fashion.
