
"Pushing to be Better, Faster, and Stronger"

Long time friend Derek Truscott (thanks for the words here Derek) will speak at Dr. Jim's memorial service May 23rd at 4:00 PM and will likely convey a message that Dr. Jim liked to relay, "a good life, like good psychotherapy and good supervision, is an interpersonal process, not an outcome" and he will likely indicate that Dr. Jim was an agnostic because he knew that the existence of God could never be conclusively proven, but believed in the power of interpersonal process. Family and friends felt that power and the love that everyone shared for Jim coming away from his last days with a desire to hold those they love a little closer everyday. Jim will be sadly missed by all those who knew him and I know I am richer for having had the pleasure of sharing the room with him!

Working with eight Members of Parliament (MP's) and two Senators as part of the month long Spinal Cord Injury/CPA Awareness Month with events across Canada, the MP's and Senators spent the day using



a wheelchair conducting their normal business which included finding wheelchair accessible washrooms, trying to access the limited wheelchair transportation on Parliament Hill, waiting for a spot in one of the few elevators in Centre Block, and attending committee meetings.

The wheelchairs were provided by Conval-Aid, OCWSA, and RGK Wheelchairs Inc. of Ottawa with Reg McClellan and Chantal Benoit offering

assistance and tips on pushing, balance, and maneuvering. The day concluded with wheelchair races amongst the participants. Justin Trudeau was the "Fastest Male MP on Wheels", Martha Hall Findlay was the "Fastest Female MP on Wheels, Steven Fletcher was the "Fastest Power Chair" user and Kurt Stoodley (of "A" Channel) was the "Fastest Media on Wheels". Next year, in recognition of their 65th anniversary, the CPA aims to have fifty-five Members of Parliament and ten Senators (sixty-five in total) spend a day in a wheelchair!
