
Americas Cup



The **Reflex™** foam now has functional areas created by two types of foam and an area of perforation. Firm foam is used for the perimeter and medial thigh separator, and medium foam is used for the thigh troughs and pelvic bucketing. Perforated foam in the sacralischial area provides maximum protection of the decubitus-sensitive area of the ITs.

This change in materials will provide users with more stability, and increase their ability to have good postural support with a non-adjustable cushion. The **Reflex™** will still feature the

built-in air-release device, which automatically releases a portion of air when the user sits on the cushion.
