## MIM 25<sup>th</sup> Anniversary

Rick Hansen shared updates in June on his foundations global outreach and their delegation's recent visit to New York, Washington and Miami.

The Rick Hansen Institute (RHI) signed a significant Memorandum of Understanding in the field of spinal cord injury (SCI) research with the James J. Peters VA Medical Center (JJPVAMC), Bronx, NY. The partnership with this world-class research facility will develop collaboration around clinical trials, research and implementation of

best practices. It is a tangible step in accelerating progress towards a cure for paralysis from spinal cord injuries. The signing was followed by a tour where Rick was joined by representatives from RHI to view a demonstration of the American innovation ReWalk exoskeleton by Lt. Ian Brown, who was injured in line of duty in the Afghan war in 2002. The ReWalk enables a person with complete motor paraplegia to walk.

While in NY, Rick was able to present United Nations Secretary-General Ban Ki-moon with one of the unique Rick Hansen medals, designed by the Royal Canadian Mint, symbolizing 25 years of progress in creating a healthy and inclusive world. The presentation acknowledged the work that the United Nations is doing to support the rights of people with disabilities.

In Washington, DC, Canadian Ambassador Gary Doer graciously hosted an event and Rick presented Judy Heumann, Special Advisor on Disability Rights, U.S. State Department, with a Rick Hansen Difference Maker Award for her many years of advocating for disability rights in the U.S. Dr. Robert Grossman from Houston also received a Rick Hansen Difference Maker Award for his work as lead investigator for the North American Clinical Trials Network, an initiative sponsored by the Christopher and Dana Reeve Foundation.

In Miami, Rick Hansen Foundation (RHF) and RHI partnered with the Miami Project to Cure Paralysis to enter into the second collaborative agreement with a U.S. research center. Also in its 25th Anniversary, the Miami Project was co-founded in 1985 by NFL Hall of Fame linebacker Nick Buoniconti after his son, Marc, sustained a spinal cord injury during a college football game. The Miami Project's international team of more than 200 scientists, researchers and clinicians take innovative approaches to the challenge of spinal cord injury.

#### **Betty Fox**

On June 25<sup>th</sup>, 2011 The Star reported that hundreds of people packed a small church in Port Coquitlam, B.C. to celebrate the life of Terry Fox's mother Betty, who died earlier in June at the age of 73.

"Betty Fox is credited with keeping her son's Marathon of Hope alive and raising millions for cancer research. Fox died in Chilliwack, B.C. after what her family described as a serious illness. Fox was remembered as a tenacious, dedicated mother who was determined to ensure her son's vision and ideals were preserved after his marathon was cut short before his death in 1981. One of her grandchildren, Kirsten Fox, told the church her family has been flooded with thousands of letters of support since Betty's death. Kirsten Fox says she saw first hand her grandmother's commitment to sharing the Terry Fox message. But Kirsten says always saw Betty as a grandmother first, a caring, silly — and sometimes serious — woman who encouraged her family to hold onto their convictions. Among the mourners were B.C. Premier Christy Clark, former Vancouver Olympic CEO John Furlong, and Rick Hansen, famous for his Man In Motion tour."
